Objectives and Investment Policy

The investment objective of the Compartment is to seek capital appreciation, and to maximize return on investments independently of market moves. In order to achieve this aim, the Compartment invests, according to the principle of risk diversification, mainly in securities in both developed and emerging markets. It may invest *inter alia* in large cap equities, Exchange Traded Funds and index futures in global markets. The Compartment is actively managed. In order to achieve diversified exposure and to profit from price changes on the market, the Compartment will use various trading and investment strategies including risk hedging, tactical use of cash and arbitrage strategies. The Compartment has also a discretionary right to swing between the above strategies.

The investment policy and objective of the Compartment may be changed by the General Partner, after AIFM approval.

In principal you may transfer the Compartment’s shares only to a well-informed investor. For more details please refer to the fund’s issuing document. Income remains in the Compartment and is reinvested.

Risk and Reward Profile



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This risk and reward indicator illustrates where the Compartment is positioned in terms of its possible risk and reward. The higher the Compartment’s position on this scale, the greater the possible reward, but also the greater risk of losing money. This risk indicator is calculated using historical data, which cannot be used as a prediction for the future. Therefore the risk classification may change over time. Even if the Compartment is in the lowest risk class you can lose money, as no investments are entirely risk free. This Compartment is in category 5 since the price changes of the Compartment have been moderate in the past. The following risks are not fully reflected in the above classification but still influence the Compartment’s value. * The quarterly performance fee is based on the increase of the net asset value per share over the relevant Calculation Period. This performance fee of 20% will be applied on the percentage rate by which the NAV per share performance will exceed 4% p.a. performance during the specified Calculation Period. The performance will be

accrued daily and paid out quarterly to the Investment Advisor.
